MINUTES OF THE ORDINARY PARISH COUNCIL MEETING HELD ON TUESDAY, 11 JULY 2023

Meeting opened: 07.00

1. Welcome & Apologies

The Chair informed all present that the meeting was being recorded for minutes purposes only and the recording will be destroyed once the minutes are approved.

- 1.1. Attended in person by Cllrs Gudgeon (Chair), Drwiega, Omar, Middleton, W/Cllr Jandu, W/Cllr Keough, seven members of the public [MoP], the Clerk and Acting Clerk.

2. Democratic Half-Hour/Public Question Time/Invited Guest Speakers

- 2.1. **Public Question Time** This time is reserved for pre submitted questions from the Public in advance of the meeting.
 - 2.1.1.Badger set Mop complained about Badger set on Thompson farm been demolished, The Chair stated it already a logged complain and ongoing issue with Bellway and Taylor Wimpey Site.
 - 2.1.2. Heavy Vehicle use thereby causing Traffic on Tamworth Road due to the New Developments. The Chair reiterates this point and mentions objections have been submitted around Transport, Environment and Access and contacting Taiwo Owatemi MP for involvement and Help however way she can.
 - 2.1.3. Bellway- Un specified Housing Structures on Tamworth Road towards Five field road, MoP suggested cooperating with Holbrooks in knowledge and Resources. Chair suggested a meeting with Planning and Transport. MOP also complained about sizes of houses on Bellway and Thompson farm been too small. The Chair suggested Organising a meeting with Planning Department.
 - 2.1.4. Discussion on Relocation of Birds. Discussion Follows
 - 2.1.5. Anti-Social Behaviour- Increase in Anti-Social behaviour on the field from free access been left open and multiple engines are being left open which can cause fire in the summer. MoP suggested having the Access closed to make it more secure and cut the grass to avoid fire in summer. Cllr Drwiega responded the City Council said the electricity board needs access and suggest they should create access for themselves by creating a secured gate to their site on the field and Grass on the field be cut for safety and follow up on it.
 - 2.1.6. Potholes- Mop discussed an issue on potholes on the road getting bigger, while the smaller ones have been fixed the huge ones have been neglected. The Chair said the potholes have been reported and accompanied with pictures as proof to the City Council and posted on social media.
 - 2.1.7.Mop discussed Objections to Planning Application going across the fields (Hare and Hound) to spring hill saying it wasn't said to be a High Level Road, and further explained Noise Pollution and Flooding. The Chair Explained the reason it was elevated and mentioned that objections that has been put forward so far.
- 2.2. **Invited Guest Speaker-** Chair Corley Parish Council, expressed displeasure and objections to the proposed building on Five Fields Road that cut through the Borders of Corley Parish Council. He Expresses the Danger it could lead to due to the limited/obstructed visibility of cars on North and South of Tamworth road.

The Chair Corley Parish Council Suggested more Objections be Submitted and have it fly high. The Chair Keresley Parish Council also agrees about the safety hazard it proposes and effect it has on the environment as there is no bus route or cycle lane in place, which will lead to Reliance of

more vehicles on the road thereby going against City Council Environmental scope. Some Suggestions came up and Discussion follows.

The Chair Corley Parish Council Also pledged Support to KPC in Objections to Planning Application, as they also have impact on Corley Area.
