UPDATE ON KERESLEY LINK ROAD

The Keresley Link Road still remains a key strategic project for the Council and the development of the Keresley SUE. We are due to start works in the coming weeks on the small section of the link road over the Hall Brook, connecting the Taylor Wimpey site through the Bellway site, up to the Vistry development. We are working with the developers to have the works brought forward for adoption as public highway later this year which will provide a route between Tamworth Road and Bennetts Road We will continue to monitor progress closely and keep residents informed.

KPC has also continued to raise resident concerns on matters such as flooding, drainage, highways, and planning, environmental issues, safety concerns, supporting local residents with various issues and ensuring that the voice of Keresley residents is heard by the relevant authorities and developers.
